On completion of their respective trade curricula, the students are offered the opportunity to undergo a trade test where they become qualified Artisans.

To date, TE has successfully trained competent Artisans for the country, particularly the industry, for immediate employment. These individuals are fully qualified, have passed their trade tests and have been equipped with theory, practical training and On the Job training (OJT).
